### Advance Notification of Out-of-Hours Working

As part of the planned construction works, Luddon Construction will be carrying out minor fencing alterations at the western end of the site.

Whilst Luddon had hoped to undertake these works during normal working hours, due to the proximity to a live rail network, for safety reasons, Network Rail require these works to be supervised and carried out under a possession i.e. whilst no trains are running. Therefore, night-time working is required for these works. A possession has been booked with Network Rail for Sunday 23rd February from 01:00 – 09:00.

There will be a period of setup during the Saturday evening with the contractor and Network Rail supervisors arriving on site at 21.00 to move plant and operatives into position. Only safety critical activities will be undertaken during the overnight possession, with the works being completed and the site vacated at the earliest opportunity.

The minor fencing alterations require the use of one excavator, with specific task lighting in use directed away from the village. Luddon Construction will co-ordinate the works to ensure minimal movement of the excavator throughout the out of hours working, and audible alarms will be disabled. The excavator is already on site therefore no further deliveries will be required to enable these works.

Luddon Construction would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience this may cause. We would like to stress that there are no alternatives to the overnight working in this instance for safety reasons, and given the need to meet with the requirements of Network Rail.

There are no further out of hours works planned.
